



Dr. John B. Tsu Asian Pacific Institute International Student Scholarship

Applications are being accepted for the Dr. John B. Tsu Asian Pacific Institute International Student Scholarship at John F. Kennedy University. Scholarships of \$2,000 are available beginning fall 2008. Two amounts of \$1,000 will be disbursed semi-annually, in fall and spring quarter. Scholarship recipients must be registered and enrolled at John F. Kennedy University as an international student (F-1 visa status) to receive a disbursement.

Applications will be evaluated on the basis of:

1. Demonstrated academic achievement;
2. Contribution to community;
3. Financial need.

Your submission packet must include the following:

1. A completed Dr. John B. Tsu Asian Pacific Institute International Student Scholarship application.
2. A typed, personal essay (500 words) that clearly describes:

Your past and present contribution to community and how receiving this scholarship will enable you to further contribute to local and global communities.

3. A copy of your passport identification page.
4. A letter of support that indicates the balance of the funding will be available to cover the first year of expenses while you study at John F. Kennedy University.

In addition, your application packet may include letters of support attesting to your past and present community service. Academic achievement will be evaluated through an examination of your academic records on file at John F. Kennedy University.
