Notes on Curriculum

* This is a non-severable course. Students must enroll in the same section of this course for each term and must complete *all* of the required units before academic credit for the course is awarded.

☞ Students must satisfy at least two (2) of the elective units with a course that meets the Perspectives in Law requirement. See the Schedule of Classes for courses that fulfill this requirement.

+ This will be offered as a 3 unit course commencing Spring 2008.

☞☞ Special Status students must take and pass the First-Year Law Students' Examination (FYLX or "Baby Bar") in **October** (for fall admits) or **June** (for spring admits) following completion of the first-year courses. Receipt of credit for courses completed after the first year of study is conditional upon passing the FYLX within three (3) administrations of first eligibility.
