



Tuition and Fees

Tuition is charged per unit. The 2007-2008 charge for tuition per unit is \$610. As the chart below indicates, each year in the program, the number of required units decreases, which in turn decreases the tuition from one year to the next.

| Year in Program | Number of Units |
|-----------------|-----------------|
| 1 | 55.5 |
| 2 | 50.0 |

| 4 | 36.0 * |
| Total | 180.0 |

* These 36 units are during the internship year. They are charged at roughly $\frac{1}{4}$ the rate of other units, at \$165 per unit.

Other fees

Comprehensive Examinations Fee: \$90
(Covers both the 2nd year written exam and the 3rd year oral exam)

Petition to Graduate Fee: \$145
(Covers complete academic audit by registrar's office)

In addition to the tuition and fees, all students are required to complete 50 hours of psychotherapy before graduation. The Graduate School of Professional Psychology keeps a list of psychotherapy providers who offer sliding scale fees for their therapy services.
